## **Patient Tips for Video Visits with your Pediatric Provider**

1 Get Ready for your Visit

Have your child with you in a well-lit room that is as quiet and free from distractions as possible.

Check your phone or email 15-20 minutes before your appointment time for the link to your video visit room.

If you do not receive a link 20 minutes before your appointment, please call the office.



2 Joining your Video Visit

For your video visit, you will need:

- A reliable internet connection
- A smartphone, computer, or tablet with a cameral and microphone.
- Web browser installed.
  Preferred browsers
  - Google Chrome
  - Safari



- Tools to have available:
- Thermometer
- Flashlight or other light source (helps us to look at your child's throat)
- Your child's weight or a scale
- A list of your child's symptoms, when they started and how severe they are.
- A list of questions for your provider.
- Name, location and phone number for your pharmacy.
- Comfort items that may make your child more comfortable (toy, blanket, etc.)



What to expect during your child's video visit

Your child's provider will need your help with your child's physical exam.

You may be asked to:

- Hold your phone to the child's open mouth so the provider can examine their throat
- Gently push on the child's belly as instructed by the provider
- Take the child's temperature



Your session will begin as soon as the provider joins the visit. Please try to join the visit 5 minutes prior to your scheduled time.
