What is PrEP?

Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis or PrEP is a daily pill for people who do not have HIV but are at high risk of getting it.

Is PrEP Right for Me?

If you are HIV negative and sexually active, it might be time to take control with PrEP if you identify with any of the following statements:

- I don't know the HIV status of my partner.
- My partner is HIV+ and may or may not be on HIV treatment.
- I don't use condoms every time I have sex.
- I've had a sexually transmitted infection in the last six months.
- I am an injection drug user, or my partner is an injection drug user.
- I am HIV negative and have asked about PrEP.

FACT: PrEP has been shown to reduce risk of HIV infection through sex for gay and bisexual men, transgender women, and heterosexual men and women, as well as among people who inject drugs.

How Can PrEP Navigation Help Me?

The PrEP navigation program at Harbor Health connects you to resources and ongoing support to help protect you from HIV.

Our PrEP Navigators can help you:

- Learn about your risk for HIV, about PrEP, and how to talk with your medical provider
- Sign up for health insurance and determine your coverage for PrEP
- Sign up for PrEP financial assistance programs so you can afford the medication
- Schedule appointments with a Harbor Health provider to talk about PrEP
- Connect you to our Harbor Health pharmacy to receive a prescription — we offer delivery by mail!
- Offer support to help you remember to take PrEP
- Access other free/affordable, confidential HIV prevention and testing services

Harbor Health offers PrEP Navigation services are free, confidential, and open to the community. You do not have to be a patient at Harbor Health to work with a PrEP Navigator. If you need a medical provider or pharmacy assistance, we can connect you to our services at Harbor.
