- Call (617) 533-2379 or (617) 533-2247 to speak with our program manager or housing case manager to learn more and complete a pre-screening of eligibility

Eligibility

- Household must have at least one person living with HIV/AIDS diagnosis
- Residency within the Boston Eligible Metropolitan Area including Plymouth
- Income within program guidelines
- Rental assistance applicants must be under considerable rent burden and/or in danger of eviction
